Title of Award

Amount and Type of Award

An award for \$1000.00 will be presented to an SRP member who has maintained continuous membership for a minimum of two years. This award is a grant and not subject to repayment.

Methods of Disbursement

Cash payment will be made upon evidence of enrollment in a qualifying institution. Cash payment may be used to help defray expenses of tuition, books, and supplies. Disbursement shall be in full for full-time course load or in two equal payments for part-time course load within one year of award.

Qualifying Institutions

Any community college, college or university accredited by a regional accrediting association will qualify.

Qualifications

- Has participated in school and/or community activities.
- Has demonstrated leadership.
- Can express him/herself well in writing.
- Seeking a degree or advanced degree in education or labor relations.
